Fill out a **volunteer application** and return it to a Library staff member.

We will review your application and contact to schedule a meeting to discuss your interest in volunteering and, our current volunteer opportunities. All applications will be kept on file for 6 months.

All potential volunteers over the age of 18 are required to provide a valid Criminal Record Check that is dated not more than 12 months prior to starting the application process. The Library will reimburse the fee for the Criminal Record Check upon assignment of a volunteer position at the Library.

- * Have you included a resume, if applicable?
- * Do you have a current Criminal Record Check?
- * Do you agree to complete Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities and Integrated Accessibility Standard Regulations Training?

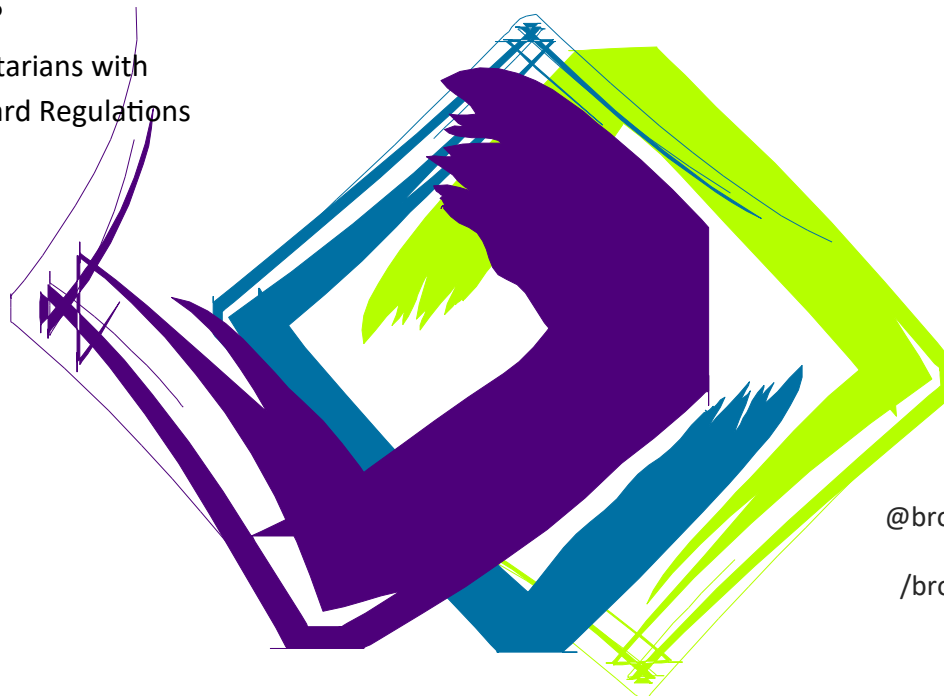
