The Brockville Public Library will be offering the Ontario Public Library Association's Silver Birch and Red Maple Award Reading Programs this year.

The goal of these programs is to encourage Ontario children to explore a variety of current Canadian children's books and to give them the opportunity to have a voice in the selection of the winning titles. Between January and April, children are encouraged to read from a selected list and then vote for their favourite titles. Winners are announced at a special award ceremony in May. **Silver Birch** is designed for children in grades 3-6 and celebrates Canadian authors and illustrators while encouraging a love of reading.
