TD Summer Reading Club

The Brockville Public Library is once again participating in the TD Summer Reading Club. Sponsored by the TD Bank Financial Group in co-operation with the Toronto Public Library and Library and Archives Canada, the TD Summer Reading Club is designed to promote reading in a setting that is fun, friendly and safe. About 450 libraries across Canada take part each year with more than 400,000 children participating. Registration in the program is free and each participant receives a kit which includes a poster, stickers, an activity booklet and a reading quest map. Upon completion of the required reading (six books over the summer) children will enjoy a pizza party sponsored by Pizza Hut in Brockville. Registration for the TD Summer Reading Program begins Friday, July 2 at the Children's Information Desk.

Summer Programs

Following the TD Summer Reading theme Destination Jungle, the library has a number of Jungle themed craft and activity programs planned for children during July and August. Help make crafts to transform the library into the wildest jungle, test your survival savvy in our Kid vs Wild programs, explore insects up close with an interpreter from St. Lawrence Islands National Park and party with jungle animals! Registration for these programs begins Monday, June 28 at the children's information desk.
