Instructions

Go to www.brockville.canlib.ca. Login to the system using your 14-digit library card number and assigned PIN# (you can obtain this at the circulation desk). From the main screen click on "Power Search. Leave all the search fields blank, but about half way down the screen click on the drop down menu beside "Location" and choose "Being acquired by the library" (list is alphabetized), and click search. This will provide you with a list of books we have on order.
