New Circulating Collection of POP-UP Books

We are in the processing of converting a collection of pop-up books that were previously reference use only. Soon you will be able to take these out and enjoy them at home.

Change in Booking Procedure for Internet

In order to better serve our patrons, we are changing the way we limit Internet usage from 1 60 session per day to a possible 120 minutes per day. This will allow patrons, depending on availability, to have up to 2 hours of Internet use either in our Sit Down area, Express Area or a combination of both.
